RE: Mandatory Water Restrictions

Dear Citizen of Bunker Hill Village:

The impact that the continued drought is having on our water system has resulted in the City Council enacting mandatory water restrictions, effective immediately.

Our city enjoys a superior water system but our increased water demand due to irrigation has continued to rise beyond record levels. In an effort to maintain the integrity of our water system, mandatory restrictions are as follows:


1. No outside irrigation during the morning hours of 4:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
2. Even number addresses may irrigate on even number dates of the month. Addresses which end in zero are even.
3. Odd number addresses may irrigate on odd number dates of the month.
4. Repair any leaks on your system.
5. Violations of these MANDATORY restrictions may result in a fine of up to a \$2,000 per day fine.

While these restrictions are mandatory, we will begin with warnings because our goal is voluntary compliance. For those who insist on not being good neighbors, citations will be issued.

These restrictions are in effect until further notice.
